\$2,000 REWARD*



On 28th July 2017, at about 4.00pm, a cat was found dead at the foot of Blk 217, Lorong 8, Toa Payoh.

The circumstances in which the cat was found are suspicious and point to an act of cruelty.

A \$2,000 reward is being offered for any information leading to the arrest and prosecution of the person/s responsible for this act. Information provided will be treated in the strictest of confidence.

Under the Animals and Birds Act, anyone who is found guilty of cruelty to animals, including abandonment of any animal, can be imprisoned for up to 18 months, fined up to \$15,000, or both.
