# **Reward: \$1000**



On Tuesday 30 August 2016, at about 3pm, a grey male cat with a pink collar and a white rabbit were found allegedly abandoned in a cage outside unit #04-101 of Blk 632B Senja Road. Both animals were bright, alert and found to be in generally good physical condition. They are currently being cared for at the SPCA. This case has also been referred to the AVA for further investigation.

The SPCA is offering a \$1000 reward for any information leading to the arrest and prosecution of the person/s responsible for this act.
