\$1,000 REWARD



On Monday, 13 February 2017, at about 2:30 pm, a Town Council cleaner found a cat in a terrible state, but still alive, inside the riser at the staircase landing between the 9th and 10th floor of Blk 577 Pasir Ris Street 53. It appeared that the cat had struggled for some time before being found.

Caregivers in the area had rushed to get the cat to the vet. Unfortunately, the cat died before they were able to do so.

The SPCA is offering a \$1,000 reward for any information leading to the arrest and prosecution of the person/s responsible for this act.
