On Wednesday, 22 February 2017, at about 11:45pm, SPCA received a call from a member of the public that a Cocker Spaniel with a brown harness was left unattended at Blk 1 Maude Road. She was unable to walk due to the extent of her matted fur, is blind in one eye, and has severe dental disease. It appears that she was severely neglected before possibly being abandoned.

The SPCA is offering a \$1,000 reward for any information leading to the arrest and prosecution of the person/s responsible for this act. ** Under the Animals and Birds Act, anyone who is found guilty of cruelty to animals, including abandonment of any animal, can be imprisoned for up to 18 months, fined up to \$15,000, or both.*
