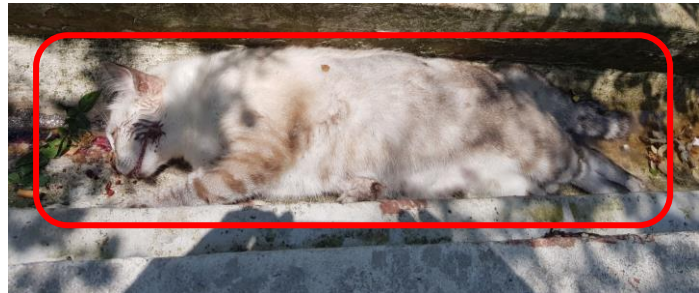

\$1,000 REWARD

On 25 October 2017, between 9.30 am to 10.00 am, two cats were found dead in the vicinity of blocks 134 and 133, Yishun Street 11.

Case 1: ginger/white cat - Blk 134

Case 2: tabby cat - Blk 133



The circumstances in which the cats were found are suspicious and point to an act of cruelty.

A \$1,000 reward is being offered for any information leading to the arrest and prosecution of the person/s responsible for this act. Information provided will be treated in the strictest of confidence.

Under the Animals and Birds Act, anyone who is found guilty of cruelty to animals, including abandonment of any animal, can be imprisoned for up to 18 months, fined up to \$15,000, or both.
