As the writer mentioned, during the recession the number of dog owners having to downgrade could also increase.

The SPCA supports the call that HDB not be too rigid when considering any appeals, as it is not easy for new homes to be found for homeless pets. With the proliferation of dogs commercially imported, bred and sold, the avenues for rehoming are limited.

A compassionate approach is needed to help people who may face the terrible dilemma of having to part with a beloved pet.
