

Instruction for DIY Cat Teasers: Tassle

- Always ensure supervised play – pets should not be ingesting any parts of the toy
- Ensure to use materials that are large enough to prevent choking

What you'll need



- 1 tweezer
- 2 scissors
- 3 elastic string
- 4 feather
- 5 bell
- 6 masking tape
- 7 yarn
- 8 stick



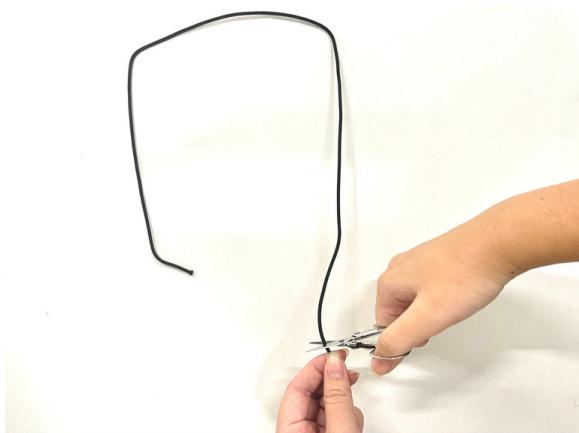

Cut ~60cm worth of elastic string



2

Cut ~40cm worth of yarn



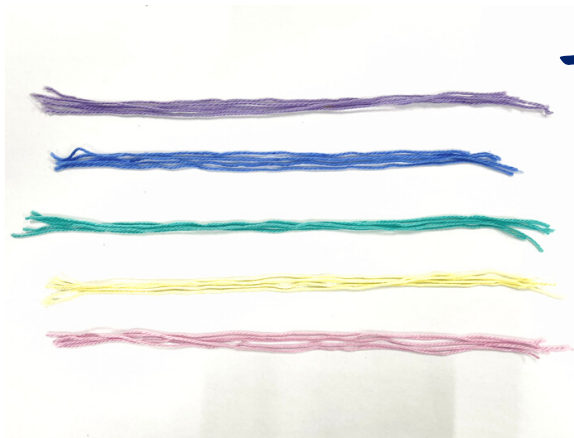

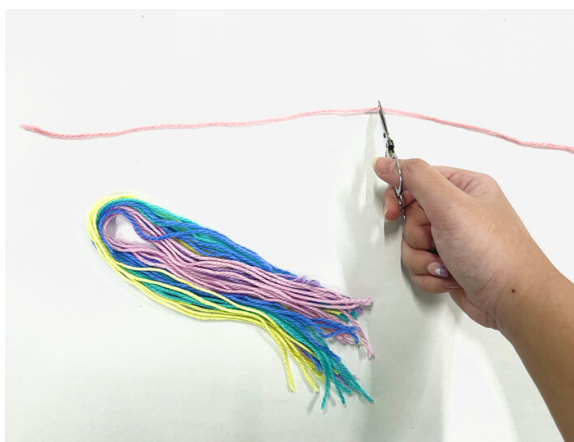
(continued) cut 5 sets of different colours of your choice: 5 strands of yarn per set (colour), it should look something like this:



→ 5 strands of yarn

Combine previous batch of yarn and fold it into half.

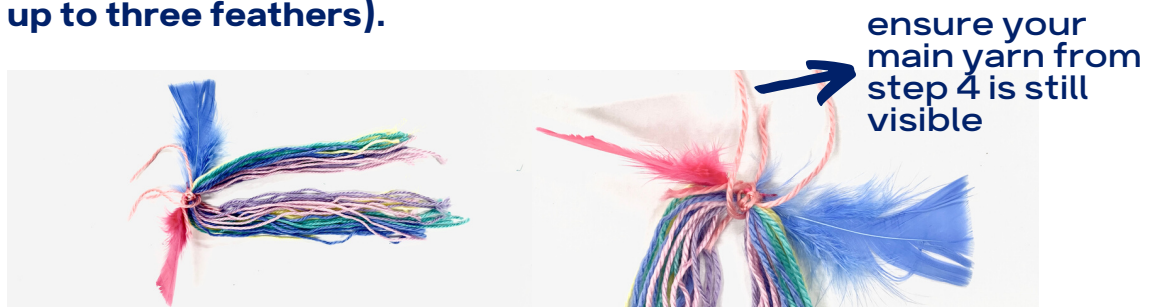

Loop the new yarn (referred to as the main yarn) through the centre fold and tie a dead knot (3 times)

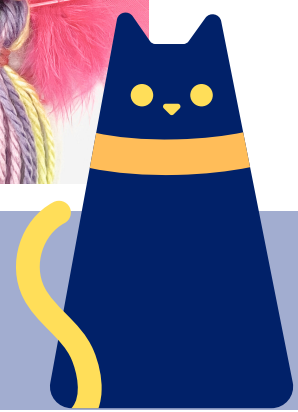
Cut another ~15cm worth of yarn and use it to secure the end of a feather. Then, secure it to the yarn (you can put up to three feathers).



**you may skip this step if you do not wish to attach feathers to your teaser*

Cut another ~ 15cm yarn. Then, use a tweezer to loop it through the bell and secure to the elastic string at the top of your tassel

Using your elastic string, tie a dead knot around the centre fold

Using your 2 strands of yarn from step 4, loop it around the tassel to create a bun at the top

If preferred, you may shorten the remaining yarn (but ensure everything is secured before cutting)



it should look something like this →



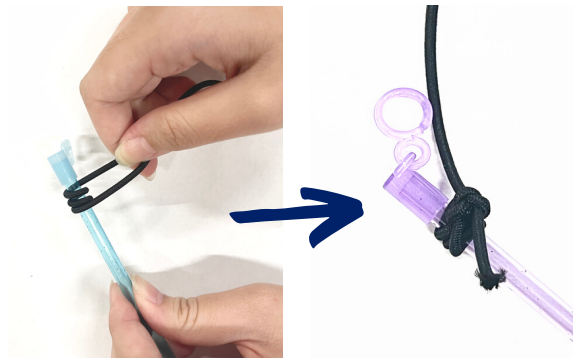

Loop the other end of your elastic string to the top of stick (loop at least three times before securing with at least three dead knots)

If preferred, pick your tape of choice and wrap around the knot to decorate it

Now you have your very own cat teaser toy! Time to go play with your cat!
